Prayer of Those Searching for Truth

Lord Jesus, You claim to be the Way, the Truth and the Life. Help me to be undaunted by the cost of following You as I consider the reasons for doing so. If what You claim is true, please guide me, teach me, and open to me the reality of who You are. Lead me into the light and life You promise. Amen.

Prayer of Belief

Lord Jesus Christ, I admit that I am more blind and sinful than I ever dared admit, but through You I am more loved and accepted than I ever dared hope. I thank You for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete acceptance. Knowing that You have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive You as Savior and Lord. Amen.
